PRP GLOSSARY—LIST COUNCIL TERMINOLOGY

X—sym. symbol used in hardware schedules to indicate a cross-keyed condition for a particular cylinder; e.g., XAA2, XIX (but not AX7)

yoke—n. a component designed to secure cylinders or turn disks in both sides of a mortise lock by means of a single setscrew

Z-wire—n. 1. a wire bypass tool with two opposing right angle bends, for retracting a spring latch, 2. a wire tension wrench for the control lug in certain IC padlocks

access control cylinder—n. a replacement for a mechanical cylinder which incorporates electronic access control and allows the original host lock to function without additional wiring or hardware modifications

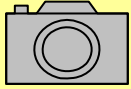

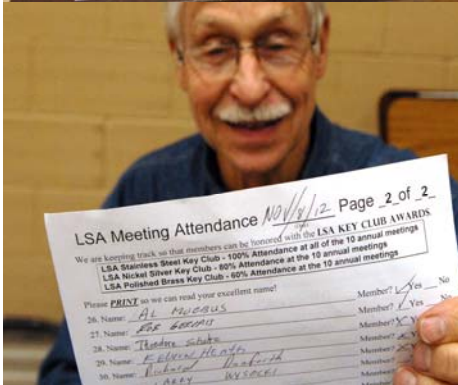
